

Escort boats: Required for all canoes - this includes IRON CREWS. Escort boats are required to have at least a \$1M GL policy or buy into HCRA's policy at https://forms.gle/xeGSRbno9EvHJS3k9

Transportation: If at all possible, please utilize your escort boat to return to Maui after the race. There is no ferry this year.

Cancellation & Refund Policy: Refunds will be given up until August 15, 2023 - there are no refunds after midnight August 15th. The Pailolo Challenge race committee will make an assertive effort to produce events as scheduled, however courses and schedules may be modified based on unforeseeable conditions arising from adverse weather, natural disaster and/or Acts of God. If the course has to be changed or the race cancelled due to unforeseen circumstances or conditions beyond our control, there are no refunds, transfers, or rollovers.

Tire Disposal Fee: If you are shipping canoes - they must be shipped on carpet. A \$50 disposal fee per tire will be assessed at registration check in.

Trailering Fee: You must select a towing arrangement on this registration form. Fees apply and are payable upon submission. **Off-Island crews - If you do not select an option you are responsible for getting your canoe to the start line and off of Molokai
